Prepare your suitcase



1.1

Use neutral colours like white, black, wheat/flesh-colored, denim.

1.2

Prefer clothes with no visible brands, no bold patterns or prints.

1.3

For undergarments, prefer smooth and seamless options if possible. Try to **avoid** thick fabric or colours that may be visible throughout the outer garment.

1.4

Choose garments that are new or relatively new and **avoid** worn-out clothes.

1.5

Avoid clothes that are crumpled.

If needed, make sure they get **ironed** before.

Place them carefully in your suitcase so they don't crease. If necessary, bring them unfolded on a hanger.

1.6

Bring a selection of the following garments:

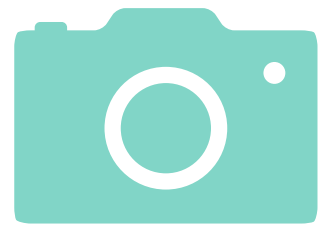
- T-Shirts
- A plain shirt, regular fit or oversized.
- Crop tops, possibly one that leaves shoulders and arms uncovered
- Jeans (one fit, one loose, one dark, one light)
- Bodysuit
- Shorts
- Leggings
- Jacket (light color denim preferably)
- Blazer
- A oversized jumper
- Socks
- Heels
- Flat shoes

1.7

If so suggested by your agency, or - if you are a freelance model - based on your own requirements, consider the following additional garments:

- Sporty undergarment
- Swimsuit
- Sportswear

On the day of the photoshoot



2.1

Get to the shoot wearing
loose clothing that does
not leave marks on your
body, no thighs waistband
or socks.

2.2

Wash your hair **the day before** your shoot, not the day of.

On the day of the shoot, keep a **natural loose hairstyle** but ensure your hair is well combed and tidy.

Bring with you a **small bag** of accessories to tie it up if needed.

2.3

Do **not** wear heavy
makeup.

2.4

Avoid wearing piercing if
possible
